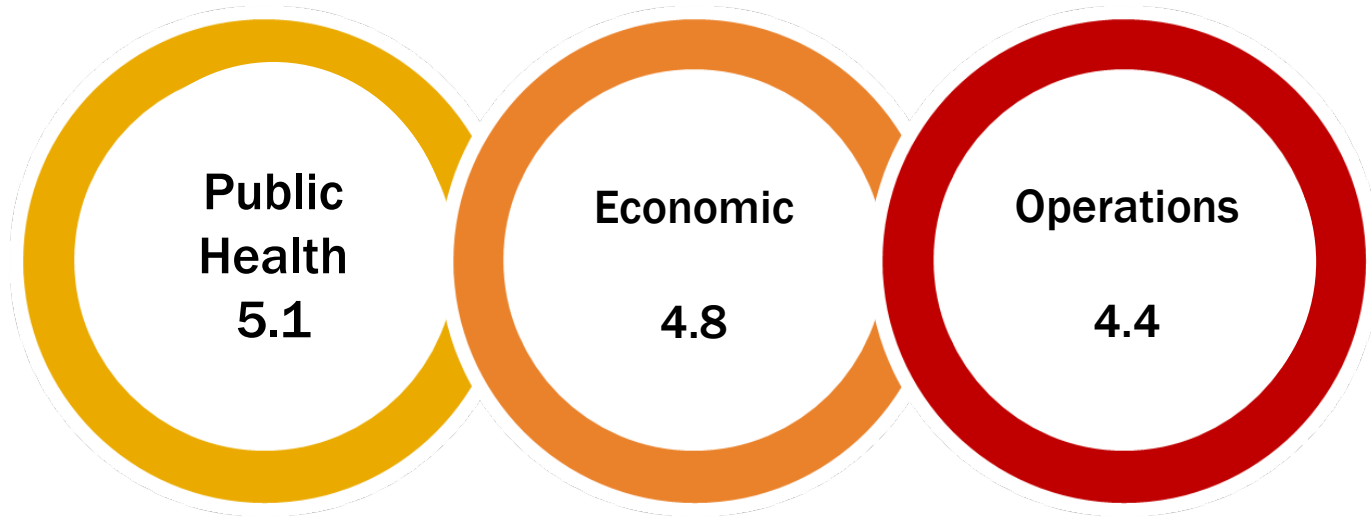

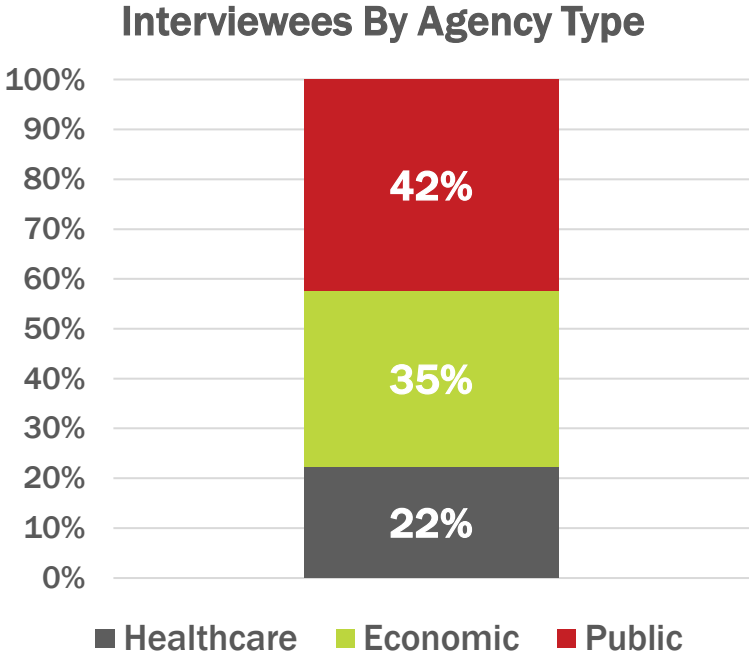

The impact has been broad across mission and mission support elements of agencies

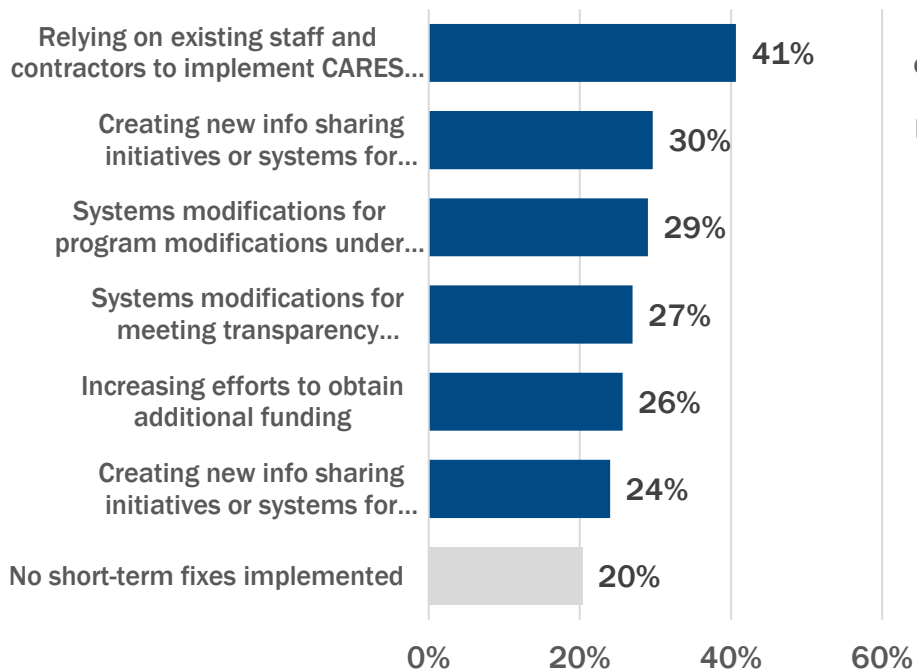
Workplace safety, managing IT systems, and financial management are the most challenging and persistent issues facing agency leaders

Preventing the transmission of coronavirus in federal facilities and office buildings for those who can't telework	78%	81%	81%
Preventing transmission of coronavirus in federal facilities and office buildings as people are brought back into the workplace	75%	75%	81%
Managing federal IT systems to permit maximum telework	79%	75%	79%
Monitoring/managing supply of personal protective equipment for agency employees	72%	76%	76%
Preventing and detecting waste, fraud and abuse	69%	75%	78%
Safeguarding federal systems from cyber attacks	70%	78%	73%
Ensuring that taxpayer funds are used efficiently and effectively	73%	69%	73%
Ensuring continued agency operation	67%	65%	80%
Providing health and safety materials to state and local governments and hospitals	52%	61%	50%
Protecting those in federal custody, patients, consumers and private sector workers in industries regulated by the fed govt	60%	58%	48%

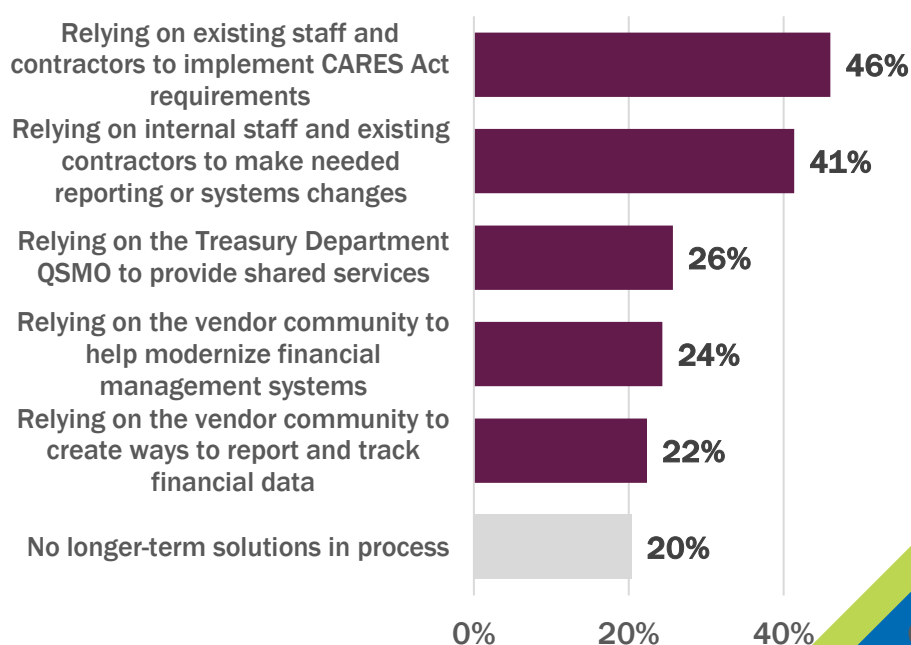
Short and Long-Term Financial Management Solutions Differ

Agencies are relying on existing staff and contractors to meet IT security and management issues, while also taking advantage of new technology to modernize applications and business practices.

Top Short Term Solutions

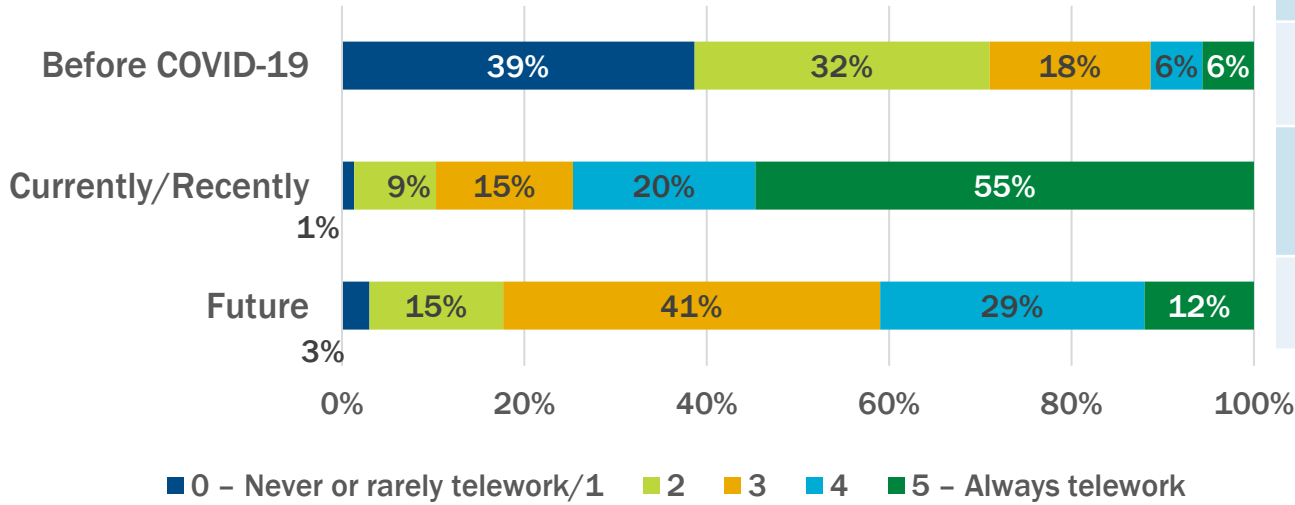
Solution	Response
Rely on existing staff and contractors for IT security & management	52%
Purchasing computers to enable most employees to telework	39%
Increasing efforts to obtain added funding for IT security & management	32%
Relying more on the vendor community for IT support	30%
Adopting Cloud-based Virtual Desktop Solutions	23%

Top Long Term Solutions

Solution	Response
Rely on existing staff and contractors for IT security & mgmt.	53%
Use new tech to modernize apps and business practices	49%
Move more apps/systems to the cloud	36%
Replace old code to modernize	28%
Modernizing/replacing the apps code	24%
